

Previous meeting - 'Access and entitlement to 'Welfare Benefits' – Apply Now!

At our June meeting guest speaker Berni Vose, Welfare Rights Advisor from Gateway M40, gave an interesting and informative perspective on the topic of 'Welfare Benefits'. Covering the diverse range of benefits members could be eligible to claim for depending on their individual circumstances, the initiation and completion of the application process and, how to appeal if the outcome proves not to be a positive one, Berni urged members to seek expert advice and to 'apply, apply, apply'.

Benefits discussed included Personal Independence Payments (PIPs), Disability Living Allowance (DLA), Attendance Allowance (AA), Employment Support Allowance (ESA), Carers Allowance, Carers Premium....all of which are claimed via the Department of Work and Pensions (DWP). Notes were circulated on some of these key benefits outlining both payment rates and accompanying DWP contact telephone numbers should members wish to make general enquiries / claims. Access to Disabled Facilities Grants, which are administered via local councils, was also discussed.

Both existing and new member attendees asked questions which were answered with gusto. For those requiring more complex responses members were encouraged to contact Berni directly via e-mail or telephone (details below) and she would do her best to help. She did state that currently, with only working one day a week, getting back to members immediately could sometimes be problematical but any enquiries would not be forgotten. Members thanked Berni for her presentation and in particular for providing an increased awareness surrounding 'all things welfare benefits'. It was very much appreciated.
